~~SCHOOL-SPONSORED  
TRIPS IN GENERAL~~

Students who participate in school-sponsored trips shall be required to ~~use~~ride in transportation provided by the ~~District~~school to and from the event, except as otherwise permitted in administrative regulations.

~~Exception may be made if the student's parent or guardian personally requests that the student be allowed to ride with the parent or presents a written request to the principal the day before the scheduled trip that the student be allowed to ride with an adult designated by the parent. The District shall not be liable for any injuries that occur to students riding in in-state vehicles that are not provided by the school.~~

OVERNIGHT TRIPS

Any in-state~~Students may be permitted to take school-sponsored overnight trips~~ taken by student for the following purposes:

- ~~1. Instructional purposes (field trips and excursions). Approval for the trip shall be from the principal.~~
- ~~2. Activities of school-sponsored or sanctioned clubs or organizations~~ and ~~Approval for the trip shall be from the principal.~~  
~~UIL or other~~ student groups ~~sanctioned competitions. Approval for the trip shall~~ require approval ~~be~~ from the Superintendent~~principal~~.

OUT-OF-STATE TRIPS

Any~~Students may be permitted to take out-of-state school-sponsored trips~~ taken by student for the following purposes:

- ~~1. Activities of school-sponsored or sanctioned clubs or organizations~~ or other student groups ~~Approval for the trip shall~~ require approval ~~be~~ from the Superintendent.  
~~Other sanctioned competitions. Approval for the trip shall be from the Superintendent.~~
