New Terminology

Term credit and Yearlong credit

- * **Term**-Students can receive credit within one semester (18 weeks).
- * **Yearlong**- students will be awarded half credit each semester to total one credit. (Same process as we currently award credit)
- * **Limited Courses**- *9 Week courses will be awarded credit at 9 weeks.*

Innovative and Flexibility by Course

- * Athletics will be Year long but with 2 term classes so students can be awarded one credit per term.
- * PE will be Term but will be paired with another PE Term class.
- * English I and English II will be year long courses
- * Algebra I will be a year long course
