	<p><u>Administrative regulations shall address student fundraising plans, approval of fundraising activities, and any required reporting on fundraisers by campus administrators.</u></p> <p><u>With at least one employee managing each project, students representing their school or the District may participate in approved fundraising to benefit the District or a nonschool, charitable organization. Participation shall be voluntary and shall be approved only when the fundraising activity relates to the District's educational mission.</u></p> <p><u>Fundraising shall not be permitted during class time. [See EC]</u></p>
<p><u>FUNDRAISING THROUGH SALES OF FOODS AND BEVERAGES THAT COULD BE CONSUMED DURING THE SCHOOL DAY SHALL MEET THE REQUIREMENTS FOR COMPETITIVE FOODS UNLESS THE DISTRICT BY OUTSIDE ORGANIZATIONS THE COMPETITIVE LOSS OF CLASS TIME AS PERMITTED BY STATE AND FEDERAL LAW. [SEE CO AND FFA] SCHOOL SPONSORED</u></p>	<p><del>Fund-raising activities by student groups and/or for school-sponsored projects shall be allowed, with prior administration approval and under the supervision of the project sponsor, for students in secondary school. Administrative procedures shall govern fund-raising activities.</del></p> <p><del>Student participation in approved fund-raising activities shall not interfere with the regular instructional program. [See EMH] Funds raised shall be received, deposited, and disbursed in accordance with CFD(LOCAL).</del></p> <p><del>No outside organizations of any sort may solicit contributions of any type from students within the schools.</del></p> <p><del>The collection of monies that takes the time of the students or teachers during school hours is strictly forbidden, unless the monies collected represent payment for school lunches, monies that will benefit the school or its students, or other authorized fees.
